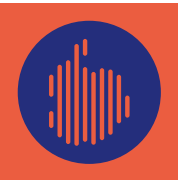

Aptenodytes forsteri

It is the largest penguin of its kind in Antarctica, weighing up to 99.2 lb and measuring up to 1.2 m tall. Its dark back, white belly, and yellowish neck highlight the emperor penguin among the ice shelves where it lives.

Therefore, in a context of climate change, science is studying how the accelerated melting of ice is affecting these species.
