Cephalorhynchus commersonii

Small dolphin (about 1.5 m) with a black and white coloration pattern. Its pectoral and dorsal fins are rounded. It's distributed in the extreme south of South America, including the Strait of Magellan, central-southern coasts of Argentina, Malvinas/Falkland Islands, and Kerguelen Islands in the Indian Ocean. Through genomic analysis, the patterns of genetic structuring/divergence between different populations are studied, as well as their potential adaptation to new environments.
